

NO PASS NO PLAY POLICY

Middle School **FESTIVAL** Sports Program

- “F” is considered a no passing grade.
- The NO PASS NO PLAY policy will be clearly stated by all coaches to their athletes at the first practice of each Festival sport. This will allow the athlete 4 weeks to improve and/or maintain their grades.
- By the completion of the third week of practice (prior to cuts) any Festival participant interested in pursuing the All Star team must be given a grade sheet to be signed by all teachers. This grade sheet must be turned into the coaches before the Festival.
- If a participant has a failing grade, they cannot be chosen for the All Star team.
- If an All Star player receives a failing grade during the All Star season, they will be suspended from play until the grade is deemed passing (“D” or better).
- Wrestling policy – athletes must be passing prior to the first match.
- Wrestling – due to the different format of wrestling, it has been suggested to create a list of wrestlers and put it on your school’s email or bulletin board so that teachers can be aware of who the team players are. The teacher could notify the coach or AD when a player has a failing grade.
