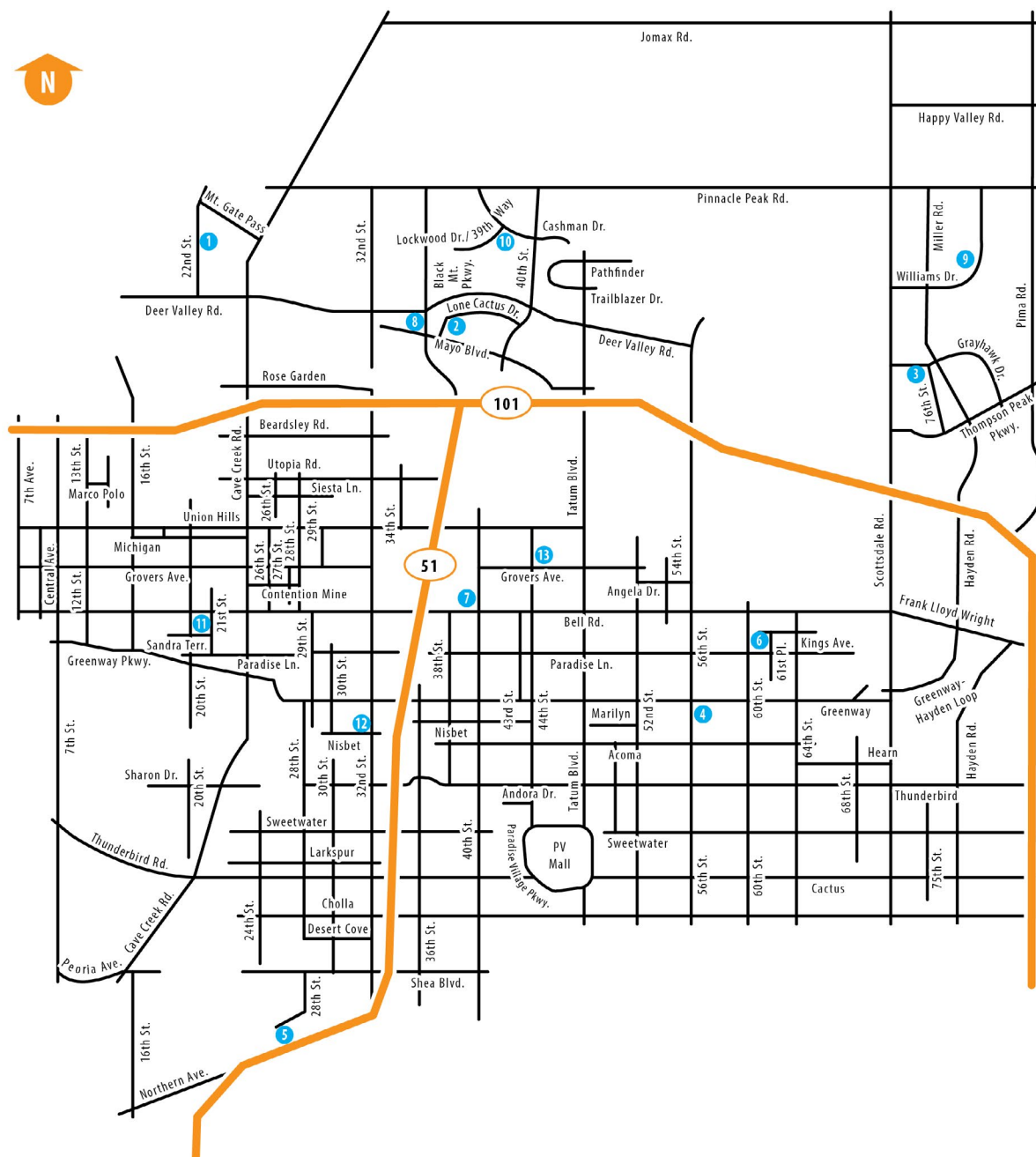
- Please visit ***pvschools.net/reopening*** for the Health and Wellness measures that PVSchools follows.

- Drop off no earlier than 10 minutes prior to start time.
- Pick up must be promptly at the published end time. A Late Pick-Up Fee of \$2 per minute will be assessed, starting 10 minutes after dismissal. On 3rd instance, child will be dropped from the program with no refund given.
- Children must be potty-trained to participate.
- There will not be a school nurse on staff during summer school.
- Children must follow all school district rules and behavior expectations. Failure to comply may result in suspension or removal from class without a refund.
- Classes may be canceled due to low enrollment.
