Call to Order: The School Council meeting was called to order in the Conference Room on November 7, 2017.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes from the last meeting were approved.

Agenda Items:

- Welcome Crystal McCabe and Officer Raines
- Roll of School Council--School Council needs to meet once per month, include community members, volunteers, agenda posted 24 hours in advance
- Equity Training--Allison and Michelle Fowler to attend November 15 and 16. Dr Lee is pushing equity and this training information will be brought back to the school. (example: boy/girl line, field trips, after school programs)
- Apex--Crystal stated PTSA meets tonight, ran smoothly, may give it a rest. PTSA will push Tuft and Needle, Coke rewards and Fry's. PTSA has 99 members. Grandparents Breakfast is November 21 at 6:30-7:45--some outside vendors to provide coffee and other items. Drawings and other items will be planned at meeting tonight.
- Student Council-Thankful Grams tie in with animal prints, Saving Paws Rescue-collecting items begins next week. Spirit week animal print and college wear
- Monthly Writing Prompts-Ms. Mantel collects the writings. K-1 can write as a group or use thinking map. Went over writing prompts to look at prompts in detail. Letters to the troops were written near September 11 and they have been sent off.
- Refresh money-about \$43,000 Items discussed 324 chromebooks will be at end of life July 2018-half of money to be spent on touchscreen chromebooks. Google doc will be created for testing skills (drag and drop, highlight, skill per grade level) for AzMerit. Psychologist will need a new computer-she needs a MAC, not a chromebook. Hold print for new printers-computers will need to be wiped clean, putting all info into the cloud. More cost efficient for chromes, need additional speaker cords, cd drives and other items for testing such as mice. Google Homes classes and noise reducing headphones were discussed
