We will continue this year with the changes we made last year to the program to help keep everyone safe during this time.

Instead of donating specific individual gifts, we are going to collect gift cards. After we collect all the gift cards we will divide them up between all the families we are helping. The gift card will allow flexibility for parents to purchase needed and wanted items, as well as safer options for shopping, like online.

Here are some specifics on how we hope to run the program this year:

How does the program work?

We are hoping to give each family approximately \$20 to spend on each child in the home, plus a gift card to help with groceries. The actual amount will be determined after we have collected all the gift cards from our school community.

What stores should I get cards to?

To allow for cohesive shopping we would prefer to give families only cards to Walmart, Target, or any grocery store.

How much/what value?

This is totally up to you. We would just ask all cards to be in increments of \$20-\$25 for ease of distribution.

Where do I turn the cards in?

Please bring them to the front office. We will have a secure drop box for collection.

When do you need the cards?

As we need to give families time to buy gifts please turn in gift cards no later than Dec. 6th.
