Dear Parents,

Mountain Trail Middle School is committed to helping students achieve academic excellence. Assignment completion helps students achieve academic success in school. Research shows that students who consistently and independently complete assignments will be more successful in school. MTMS used this research to develop the 9th Hour Study Hall that reinforces responsibility by encouraging students to complete and turn in their work on time. In addition, it gives students the opportunity to get extra help with their studies.

It is our philosophy that the consequence for not doing the work, is to finish the work. In other words, we do not accept failure as an option. It is our expectation that all students come to school with homework completed and ready to hand in on the scheduled due date. Our teachers are dedicated to providing your child with a high-quality education and assistance. If your child does not understand a question or cannot find an answer, it is his/her responsibility to seek the teacher's help prior to the time that the assignment is due.

There are two ways for a student to attend 9th Hour. One, a student may be referred to 9th Hour by his/her teacher or counselor because of missing assignments or dropping grades. When this is the case, your child, child's teacher or counselor will contact you. Two, a student or parent may request to attend 9th hour as a way to get help with a homework assignment or to just have a quiet place to get a jump start on homework. Either way, the purpose of 9th Hour is to give students an opportunity to complete schoolwork, study for tests, ask for help, or use the computers at school to write reports, do research, etc.

If you would like your student to take part in our 9th Hour Study Hall, please complete the enclosed form and return it, along with a payment of \$25 per Quarter, to the front office. If your child is referred to 9th hour due to low grades or missing assignments and you wish to decline this opportunity for your child, you may sign an opt out form available in the office. Late busses will be available.

9th Hour Program: Student/Parent Expectations

9th Hour Study Hall is intended to provide the students of MTMS an additional learning opportunity in a safe, orderly and welcoming environment. Whether you volunteer to participate or are mandated due to missing assignments or low grades, the following are the expectations for everyone while attending 9th hour.

- Students should use the time from 3:41pm-3:45pm for bathroom trips, drinks and snacks. No food or drinks other than water are allowed in 9th hour.
- Students must sign-in each day and indicate how they are getting home (Walk, Bus, Pick Up).
- Students must come to 9th Hour prepared with work to complete or study.

- Students are expected to remain productively on task while in 9th Hour. If time is not used wisely, or there are behavior issues, students may be asked to not attend in the future.
