❖ **Field Seats For Graduation:** Saturday, May 9th at 7:00 AM, Project Grad will be selling field seating tickets for the graduation

ceremony. Graduation ceremony is Thursday, May 21, 2020. Tickets are \$25 each and a maximum of 6 tickets per graduate may be purchased. Only parents of students who have paid for the after-graduation party, "Project Grad," will be eligible to buy field seating. Seats are LIMITED and go fast. Tickets will be sold on a first come-first served basis.

❖ **Senior Photo Collage:** Photo collage poster board will be provided to each senior with directions on the back. These collages will be posted for viewing during the Senior Breakfast. Poster board will be available for pickup in the student's Government/Economics classroom or in the Guidance office.

❖ **Senior Checkout:** Begins on Thursday, May 14th, and ends at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, May 19th. This is **mandatory** for all senior students whether or not they graduate or walk in the ceremony. Senior Checkout forms will be available in the Media Center on Thursday, May 14.

❖ **Senior Awards Night:** Tuesday, May 19, 2020 at 7:00 PM in the Performing Arts Center. This ceremony celebrates student

accomplishments. Scholarships will be acknowledged from local universities, awards will be presented to seniors who have been chosen by faculty for their amazing dedication to excellence and leadership. Students being honored and parents will receive an email invitation to the ceremony.

❖ **Graduation Practice:** Thursday, May 21st, promptly at **7:30 AM** in the Jerry Conner Gym. **ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY, AND TARDINESS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** Consequence of either will be non-participation in the graduation ceremony that night.

❖ **Senior Breakfast:** Thursday, May 21st, immediately following graduation practice in the Activity Center.

❖ **Graduation Ceremony:** Thursday, May 21st at 7:30 PM. Gates open at 6:30 PM. First come-first served stadium seating. Graduates are to meet in the Jerry Conner Gym no later than 6:30 PM and are expected to dress accordingly for a ceremonial event. Graduation begins promptly at 7:30 PM. Allow 1 1/2 -2 hours for the ceremony duration.

❖ **Project SAFE Grad Party:** Thursday, May 21st. Don't miss out on this great night! Buses begin leaving the school at 9:30 PM (right after graduation), and the final bus leaves at 10:30 PM. Payment and registration are due prior to the event, turn in your form to Gayda in the Guidance office.

### GENERAL INFORMATION
